Dear Parents/Guardians:
This is to follow-up on our conversation that occurred on about your child's interest and need to access accommodations and increase independence through the use of assistive technology to support learning. At this time, we would like to offer your child an opportunity to trial use of the equipment for approximately four months.
Your child will be supported in the use of the assistive technology by school personnel. Your child's Individual Education Plan (IEP) will be updated to reflect the intended use of the assistive technology. In addition, Student Services Learning Support Coordinator can also provide assistance, upon request.
 Determining the success of this trial period is important. Indicators of success include the following: Increased overall achievement in your child's engagement, representation of ideas, and expression of their thinking as evidenced by educator observations and student comments Evidence that the assistive technology accommodations or modifications indicated in the IEP are supporting learning Evidence of use of the assistive technology by viewing work samples
At the end of a successful trial, the assistive technology can be formally assigned to your child as per Special Equipment Amount (SEA) Guidelines. If the trial is not successful, we will consult with you about next steps.
